1. Introduction is well written, brief, interesting, and compelling. It motivates the work and provides a clear statement of the problem. It places the problem in context. The research questions are stated and the whole work is properly introduced.
2. Literature review is comprehensive and complete. It synthesizes a variety of sources and provides context for the research. It shows the author's understanding of the most relevant literature on the subject matter.	Outstanding Very good Acceptable Somewhat deficient Very deficient	The theoretical part is based on a sufficient number of sources both general regarding teaching and more specific involving teaching vocabulary. The chapter is arranged very well and contains a large portion of useful information. However, I cannot agree with the introductory sentence (p.2): "This chapter builds the theoretical part of the following research and <i>should answer the research questions</i> mentioned above." The answers to the research questions are to be found after the whole research and from the data collected in it (!). It is not the task of the theoretical chapter.
3. The methodology chapter provides clear and thorough description of the research methodology. It discusses why and what methods were chosen for research. The research methodology is appropriate for the identified research questions. 4. The results/data are analyzed and interpreted effectively. The chapter ties the theory with the findings. It addresses the applications and implications of the research. It discusses strengths, weaknesses, and limitations of the research. The commentary is completed by clear charts, which have a unified form and are thus easily understandable to follow. After each part the results are successfully summarized and an analysis is given.
